I'm reaching out to you to let you know about a new initiative that might interest you.

The Trial Innovation Network is a resource for investigators **interested in conducting multi-center clinical trials and studies**. This is funded by National Center for Advancing Translational Science. The goal of the Trial Innovation Network is to provide a new model for clinical trials and a flexible resource that allows investigators to choose from a menu of basic consultations and services or comprehensive consultations. If comprehensive consultations services are selected then key stakeholders at the CTSA Program Hub level are engaged before funding decisions are made and potential sites are asked to recruit patients.
