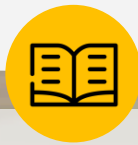

COURSE GOALS

- To provide a **foundation** in key components of clinical research design.
- To facilitate the **development** of research protocols, including for foundation grant and pilot award applications .
- To improve the **reporting quality** of clinical and translational research studies.



COURSE INFORMATION

- This course is designed for residents, fellows, and all faculty levels as a practical introduction to clinical and translational research methods.
- Applicants must identify a research topic and faculty advisor.
- Tuition: \$500
- Enrollment is limited to the first 80 accepted applicants.



COURSE FORMAT

- This course is a flipped classroom format and is held via Zoom online.
- Students are required to review pre-recorded lectures prior to class. Lecture discussions start at 10am, and small group breakout sessions are at 11am.
