- •To facilitate the development of research protocols, including for foundation grant and pilot award applications.
- •To improve the reporting quality of clinical and translational research studies.

- •This course is designed for residents, fellows, and all faculty levels as a practical introduction to clinical and translational research methods.
- Applicants must identify a research topic and faculty advisor.
- •Tuition: \$500
- •Enrollment is limited to the first 80 accepted applicants.

At the end of 8 weeks, you will have a complete research protocol!

Students and alumni will be eligible for a \$1,500 pilot research award

COURSE FORMAT

- •This course is a flipped classroom format and is held via Zoom online.
- •Students are required to review pre-recorded lectures prior to class. Lecture discussions start at 10am, and small group breakout sessions are at 11am.
